



Guns in the Workplace

Texans can carry handguns without a license or training starting September 1, 2021, after Governor Abbott signed the permit-less carry bill into law. House Bill 1927 eliminates the requirement for Texas residents to obtain a license to carry handguns if they're not prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a gun.

The new law does not change a governmental entity's inability to prohibit guns on its premises or its inability to post signage prohibiting guns. The Government Code, however, does allow public employers to bar employees from carrying guns.
