



LEGAL CONSULTING SERVICES FOR MEMBERS

The Texas Water Conservation Association Risk Management Fund (Fund) wants to remind you of the consulting service available to members of the Fund's Liability Program. As of July 1, 2021, members have access to attorney Joel Geary (and his designated partners) to ask legal questions on potential liability matters. This service is offered as a liability loss prevention measure. **There is no additional charge to members to consult with Mr. Geary.** This service is intended to complement, not replace, members' local counsel.

Some examples of how this service might be utilized:

 Responding to member's phone calls and emails for purposes of educating and limiting liability exposures.

Example: A member might call Mr. Geary when considering termination of employee to talk through the termination and to ensure they have appropriate documentation to move forward.

 Serving as an initial resource to members, from a legal perspective, when a crisis occurs such as an employee fatality or operational malfunction or catastrophe.

Example: A member might call Mr. Geary for counsel on how to respond to the media making inquiries on a recent fatality at the district.

 Assisting members with review of policies and procedures and manuals aimed at limiting liability exposures.

Example: A member might be considering a change to one of its personnel policies and request that Mr. Geary review the proposed changes.

 Consulting with members regarding emerging liability exposures and how best to limit exposure to these risks.

Example: A member might seek counsel related to their plan to have employees return to working in the office as the pandemic eases after having worked from home for an extended period.

Mr. Geary has defended Fund members in lawsuits filed against them for over 20 years and has a strong knowledge of governmental immunity and the Texas Tort Claims Act and how it does and does not apply to Fund members. Mr. Geary is also very knowledgeable of employment law matters. Having worked with districts and authorities for many years, he has developed a good understanding of members operations and liability exposures.

We encourage members to take advantage of this new service, especially when faced with a liability exposure and the possibility of a liability claim.
