### CORE SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT TRAININGS

#### **Defensive Driving**

Promotes safe driving behaviors for employees who operate vehicles on behalf of the member.

### **Accident & Incident Investigation**

Focuses on determining root causes to prevent future incidents.

- When and how to investigate incidents
- Evidence collection techniques
- Root cause analysis
- Corrective action development

## **OPERATIONS & FIELD SAFETY TRAININGS**

### **Heavy Equipment Safety Best Practices**

Applies to employees operating or working around heavy equipment.

- Operator responsibilities

### **Excavation & Trenching Safety**

Addresses high-risk excavation activities and regulatory requirements.

Designed for employees working on or near energized electrical systems.
